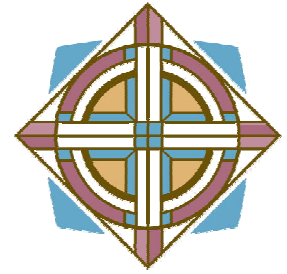

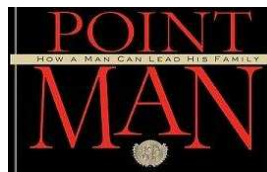
Book Club

Stewpot's Christmas in July

This year's food drive for Stewpot's Pantry (a.k.a. "Christmas in July") was an outstanding success. One hundred thirty (130) large paper grocery bags were filled to the rim with various nutritious food items, as the photos show.

According to Stewpot statistics, the Food Pantry serves almost six hundred (600) people, including parents and children, each month. Families and individuals are carefully screened and, after approval, their record will remain with the Food Pantry. Each family is given a four-day supply of groceries to cover the entire household. The Food Pantry does not give food to the same families or individuals every week or every month, but only to those who have fallen on hard times.

Not surprisingly, the demand for these basic necessities has been much higher this year

than before, so your gift will be put to good use.

Your tender hearts, once again, have responded in an amazing way. For Stewpot I want to thank all of you who contributed in any way to this campaign.

In the words of Thomas à Kempis: "The outward deed without charity is little to be praised, but whatever is done from charity, even if it is ever so little and worthless in the sight of the world, is very profitable before God, who judges all things according to the intent of the doer, not according to the greatness or worthiness of the deed."

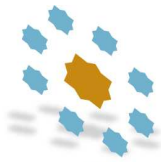
