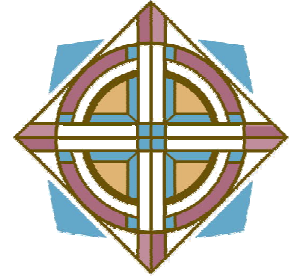

Blankets for Benjamin

In a recent edition of *Windows*, there was an article regarding the collection of blankets for children at the Maison des Enfants de Dieu orphanage in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. A box has now been placed in the foyer for these blanket donations. Sheets or similar weight coverings rather than heavier blankets are needed because of the climate in Haiti. A sheet-blanket should be no heavier than a light weight receiving blanket. Hand made or store bought sheet-blankets/ flat twin sheets in patterns and colors appropriate for children of all ages will bring comfort and smiles to many. The goal is to raise 130 blankets for children ages newborns to teenagers. The adoption agency that helped Delia & Bo Owens bring Benjamin home, CCAI, has an ongoing relationship with Maison des Enfants de Dieu orphanage and will deliver the blankets to the orphanage.

If you can help with this effort please put the sheet-blankets in the collection box. If you would like to give a monetary donation, there is a box on the table in the foyer.
