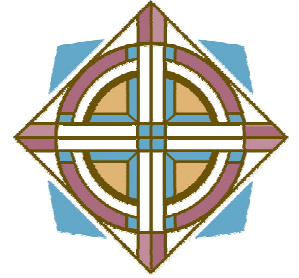

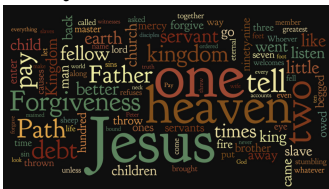

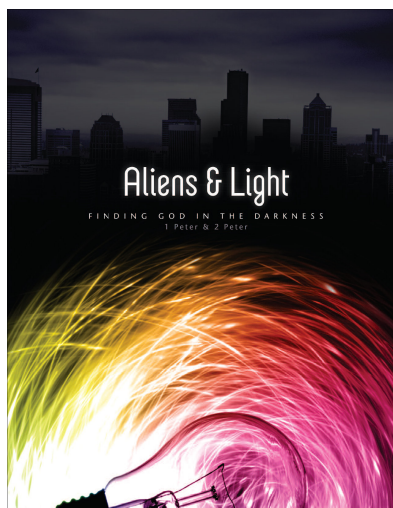
### Women's Circle
