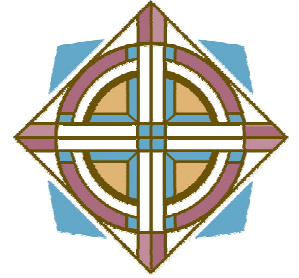

Nursery Q and A

At what age can my baby go to the nursery? Birth through two years old are cared for during Bible class and worship. Classes are set up similar to the school year. If your child is two by September, they will stay in the two year old class for the year. If your child turns three during the year, they will not be promoted until the following September.

At 9:30 a.m. babies that can sit up, ones, and twos have Bible class. This is a critical time for babies to learn God made them and God loves them in age appropriate activities.

At 10:30 a.m. children stay in the classroom, but different volunteers take over for this hour.

Is there a place I can nurse? Yes, we have a couple of comfy chairs in a private place right down the hall from the nursery in room 108.

How does the pager system work? Parents are given a pager so we can let you know if there is a problem. No buzzing pager means no problem! Parents take a pager, and write down the number on a pager sign-out form. Upon returning the pager, parents check the return box on the same form.
