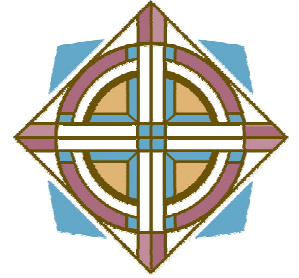

Timber Creek registration forms are available online and on the table outside the church office. Deadline for registering is Friday, July 11. COUNSELORS are needed. See Scott ASAP.

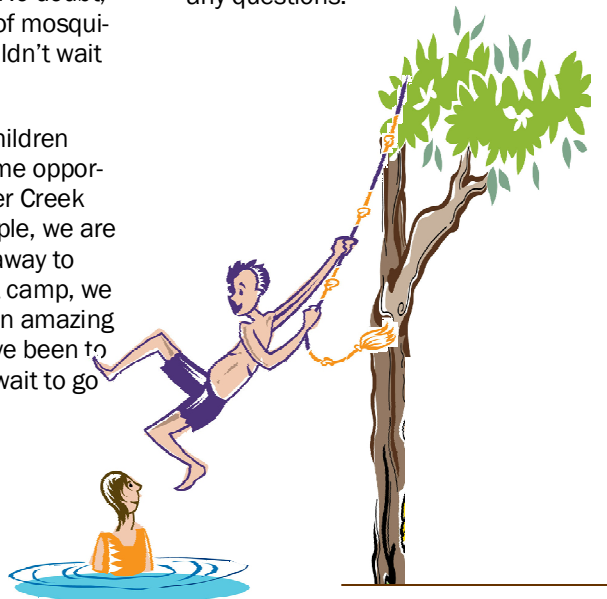
