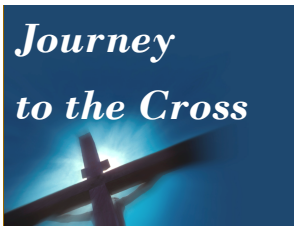

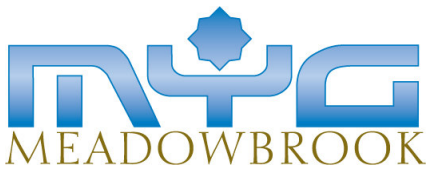
### Community Meeting
