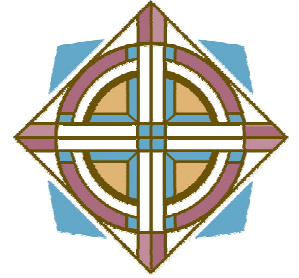

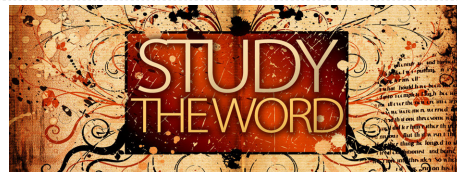

### Sunnybrook Children's Home

#### Spring Food Drive

Thanks to all of you who participated in the food drive for Sunnybrook. We filled the four big blue boxes to overflowing! Even Jerry Neill's baseball team participated with many donated items. They have been using Sunnybrook's baseball field for practicing, and the team wanted to do something nice for the Sunnybrook kids.

Here's a sort of tally of all the things we, as the hands and feet of Jesus, collected to give to the children of Sunnybrook: 16 boxes of cereal, 8 different kinds of snack foods, 7 jars of salad dressing, lots of Koolaid, 3 boxes of tea bags, 3 jars of vegetable oil, 5 cans of fruit, 11 cans of vegetables, 156 rolls of toilet tissue, 44 rolls of paper towels, 37 boxes of Ziplock bags, 4 jars of Pine Sol, 5 boxes/bottles of laundry detergent, 4 containers of Cascade dishwashing detergent, 3 bottles of Clorox, 11 boxes of dryer sheets, and many other various food items.
